District Context	<p>This large urban district, comprised of over 139,000 students across 240 schools, partnered with engage2learn (e2L) to support more than 260 middle school teachers, 75 campus leaders, and 30 Campus Instructional Coaches (CICs) across 23 middle school campuses. Grounded in e2L's research-based methodology, the partnership prioritized two key areas: Strategic Instructional Practices and Transformative Positive Culture.</p> <p>To ensure a high return on investment and sustained impact, the partnership's core support model was job-embedded, role-specific coaching for teachers, CICs, and campus leaders.</p> <p>Throughout our engagement, we served approximately 365 educators to accomplish the following goals:</p>
