District Context	Rural school district with 2 middle schools (grades 6-8) and 2 high schools (grades 9-10) with 16 ELA teachers total and 12 instructional leaders total  We offered comprehensive, workshop-style training designed to empower teachers and instructional leaders, including principals, assistant principals, and instructional coaches. Over the course of three days, participants engaged in a deep analysis of curriculum, standards, and assessments.  Our initial training aims to build a foundation for the successful implementation of instructional strategies with fidelity, ensuring a measurable impact on student achievement.  For each school, the focus was on achieving an increase of 25% in ELA/Reading assessment scores on the end-of-year state assessments for 6th, 7th, 8th, and 10th grades. By focusing on data-driven teaching practices and targeted instructional support, we set the stage for lasting improvements in student outcomes.
