What Does Being a PLPG Partner Mean?

PLPG partners are uniquely qualified to support implementation of HQIM. For inclusion in the PLPG, PL services must demonstrate:

- Content and HQIM Expertise (Gateway 1)
- Quality of Professional Learning Design (Gateway 2)
- A Clear Process for Measuring Results and Using Data to Plan and Improve their Services (Gateway 3)

Each application undergoes a thorough, objective review process by a trained team of educators, giving decision-makers confidence that a provider's services can support them in meeting their goals.

Am I Eligible to Apply?

Any and all professional learning organizations who specialize in providing HQIM-specific support are invited to apply. This includes local, regional (e.g. regional service centers), and national providers.

Step 1:	Create an account in the PLPG portal.
Step 2:	Attend an informational webinar about Gateway 1. (See dates below.)
Step 3:	Submit your Letter of Interest (new providers- March 21 renewing providers - April 4.
Step 4:	Submit Gateway 1 materials by April 15.
Step 5:	Attend an informational webinar about Gateways 2 & 3. (See dates below.)
Step 6:	Submit Gateway 2 and 3 materials between by June 17.
Step 7:	New providers are announced August 26.
